

Vote NO on Issue 8 Northwest Local Tax

The proposed Northwest Local School District Levy is a <u>\$410 Tax Increase</u> for the Average Homeowner!

The burden of property taxes continues to grow without any end in sight!

Despite the State of Ohio budgeting <u>billions</u> for education:

- 9.84 billion dollars in FY 2021
- 10.23 billion dollars in FY 2022
- 10.43 billion dollars proposed for FY 2023

Despite the Ohio Supreme Court ruling in 1997 that the current Ohio school funding method is **Unconsitutional.**

Passage of Another Northwest Schools Levy will not solve the problem!

- This same Northwest Local School District levy
 <u>failed by more than 60 percent</u> in November 2022.
- It will be on the ballot again in May 2023.
- If it fails in May, the district will place the issue on the ballot again and again until threats and fatigue force a Yes vote.

It's time to vote for education not higher taxes!

End Ohio's Educational State of Emergency

Insist on a fair statewide constitutional school funding model.
