

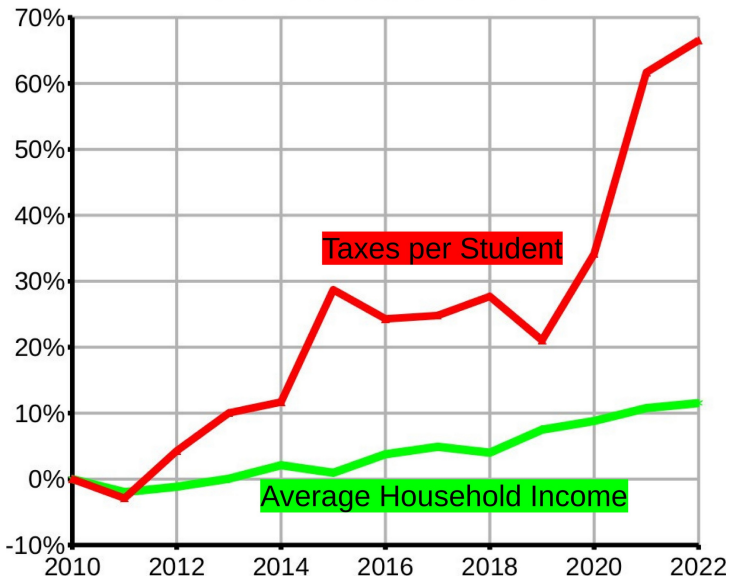


Vote NO on May 2nd

Taxes per Student vs Average Family Income in Northwest Local since 2010



Household income is up less than 12%, Taxes per student is up over 65%!!!

Northwest District has increased taxes five times faster than the taxpayer's income!!!

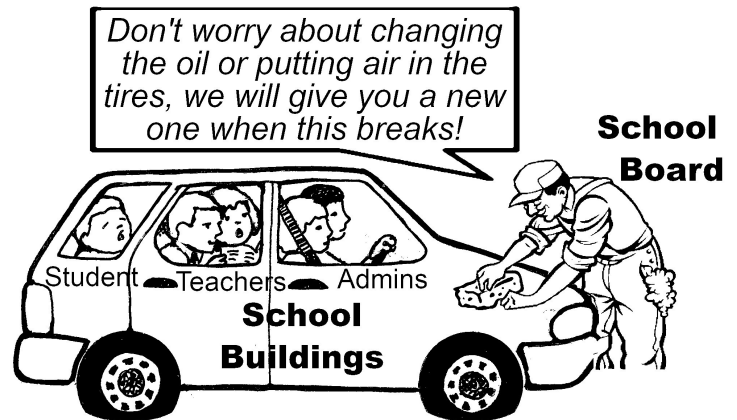
Northwest School District comparison to Oak Hills School District

- Taxes per Student
 - Oak Hills: \$12,257.20
 - Northwest: \$15,714.13, **28.2% higher**
- Property taxes per Student
 - Oak Hills: \$4,559.62
 - Northwest: \$7,766.41, **58.7% higher**
- Administrators per 1,000 students
 - Oak Hills: 5.33
 - Northwest: 7.49, **40.1% higher**

In spite of all the extra money and administrators, Northwest is rated at 2 stars and Oak Hill is 4 star!

This levy will cost near \$400 million to get \$168.6 million to construct new schools.

Meanwhile NWLSD admits to \$40 million in deferred maintenance on the buildings they already have.

Northwest School must live within their already enormous budget!

New buildings do not guarantee better performance. In fact, the top rated school in Northwest is Colerain Elementary, 99 years old and the oldest school in the district!
